a) "Scholarship Scheme (Trust Fund)":

Under this scheme, 1,000 Scholarships are provided to eligible differently - abled students for degree and post graduate level professional and technical courses from recognized institutions. The students may apply online (www.nhfdc.nic.in (www.nhfdc.nic.in)) at any time during the year and submit hard copy of the application to "National Handicapped Finance & Development Corporation (NHFDc), Red Cross Bhawan, Sector - 12, Faridabad - 121007" . Reimbursements of Non - Refundable fees restricted to limit of fee of similar courses. Monthly income of the beneficiary / parent / guardian should not be more than Rs 25,000/- (Rs 3.00 Lac p.a.) from all sources.
